Winter Cancellation Policy

Providing a safe environment during those times when the winter season brings ice and snow conditions to our facility, everyone's safety is our utmost concern. Our parking areas and sidewalks can be extremely hazardous for driving and walking.

The following policy is a guide for the cancellation or postponement of Worship Services, Office Operations, Day Care Operations, and all other activities and programs held at our campus.

Worship Services: When snow and or ice are present making driving or walking a hazard, worship

services will be canceled or postponed. The Pastor in consultation with the Governing Board Chair

will make the final decision to cancel or postpone.

Office Operations: If Shell Knob Schools are closed the office will be closed.

Day Care Operations: If Shell Knob Schools are closed the Day Care will be closed. After parking areas and walks have been cleared and treated the Director may utilize delayed opening, early release, and staff to child ratioing to provide care. (This means daycare could open, even if Shell Knob School closes). The Director will work in consultation with the Pastor and Governing Board Chair in making the final decision. The Director will post on Facebook and send a message on Brightwheel by 6:00am.

Activities and Programs: Until parking areas and walks have been cleared and treated all activities and programs will be canceled or postponed. The Pastor in consultation with the Governing Board Chair will make the final decision.
